Please refer to *page 2* for a template of the LOI. Applicants that do not submit a completed template LOI by the deadline will not be considered for funding.

- 1. The LOI is non-binding and Applicants submitting a letter may elect not to submit an application.
- 2. Answer the questions and fill in the information required on the template LOI provided on page 2 of this appendix. The LOI <u>must</u> be submitted on the Applicant's agency letterhead and signed by the authorized agency signatory or official agent.
- The LOI will only be accepted via the Tobacco Control Funding Opportunities and Resources (TCFOR) <u>website</u>. The LOI will <u>not</u> be accepted via the United States Postal Service, express mail, email or fax.
- 4. Prepare the LOI using word processing software and save the document to your computer as a word document or PDF. To upload the LOI, refer to Appendix 8: *Tobacco Control Funding Opportunities and Resources (TCFOR) User Instructions*. Once the Applicant creates a "User Account" and "Request to Apply" for the funding opportunity, a LOI can be uploaded.
- 5. The LOI must be uploaded to the TCFOR <u>website</u> by **5:00 p.m. PT, on August 4, 2020.**
- 6. The electronic time stamp will be used to verify on-time submission. Technical difficulties will not relieve the applicant of meeting the submission deadline. It is strongly advised that applicants submit their LOI prior to the due date in case technical difficulties are encountered.
