

CALIFORNIA TOBACCO CONTROL PROGRAM (CTCP) REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) 14-10004 PUBLIC RELATIONS CAMPAIGN

Purpose of RFP: Award a single contract to conduct the statewide CTCP Public

Relations Campaign, which would reach the general market and

selected ethnic and priority population markets.

The purpose of the RFP is to identify the public relations agency

most capable of creating and implementing a continuously innovative campaign to raise awareness among California's diverse populations about the dangers of tobacco use and

secondhand smoke.

Term: January 1, 2015* – December 31, 2016*. The contract may be

extended up to an additional three years.

Funding: Approximately \$1.3 million is estimated to be available from the

Health Education Account, Cigarette and Tobacco Products

Surtax Fund for the two-year period.

Funding for this procurement is contingent upon available

revenues in the Governor's Budget for fiscal year (FY) 2014-15

and subsequent FYs.
