## Southern California Tribal Tobacco Coalition 3rd Annual Inter-Tribal Tobacco Prevention Youth Summit Satisfaction Survey Results

The Inter-Tribal Tobacco Prevention Youth Summit took place at the Rincon Ball fields on August 17, 2023. A total of 136 participants attended the event, of which 64 were youth and 41 completed the satisfaction survey. In addition, members of the following tribes were present, Bishop Paiute, Cahcicla, Hopi, La Jolla, Los Coyotes, Luiseno, Naee Yoeme, Navajo, Pala, Pauma, Rincon, San Luis Rey, San Pasqual, Pala, Santa Ysabel, SDAIHC, Seminole Nation, Shoshone, Soboba, and White Earth.

The participant's average age was 40. The gender identity of the participants was: Female (63%) and Male (37%). The participant's ethnic background was: Alaska Native/American Indian (68%), Other (27%), White, non-Hispanic (2%), and Hispanic or Latino (2%). Of the 11 participants who selected "other" they identify as two or more ethnicities and the remaining one participant who selected "other" identifies as "Xicano".

## **Event Satisfaction Continued**

Overall, 83% of participants were happy with the Youth Summit, 34% "Very Happy" and 49% "Happy", and 17% were neither happy or unhappy. Based on their experience with the Youth Summit the participants were asked how likely they are to attend next years event, 32% "Cannot wait to attend", 46% "Will attend", and 22% "Are not sure".

The sessions had high levels of satisfaction, as the following satisfaction levels were shared: 75% for "Dancers/Bird Singers", and 90% for the "Matching Game".



136 tribal community members attended the Youth Summit



Seventy-three percent (73%) of participants were satisfied with the race/walk and 78% with the keynote speaker from CYAN. The "Environment: Tobacco Waste" presentation left 98% of participants either "Very Happy" or "Happy".

83% Of the participants were Satisfied with the 3rd Annual Youth Summit.

The majority (95%) were either "very happy" or "happy" with the lunch. Similarly, 88% were happy with the tables and giveaways.

The data collected from the Southern California Tribal Tobacco Coalition Youth Summit will be used to make improvements to future youth summits.
