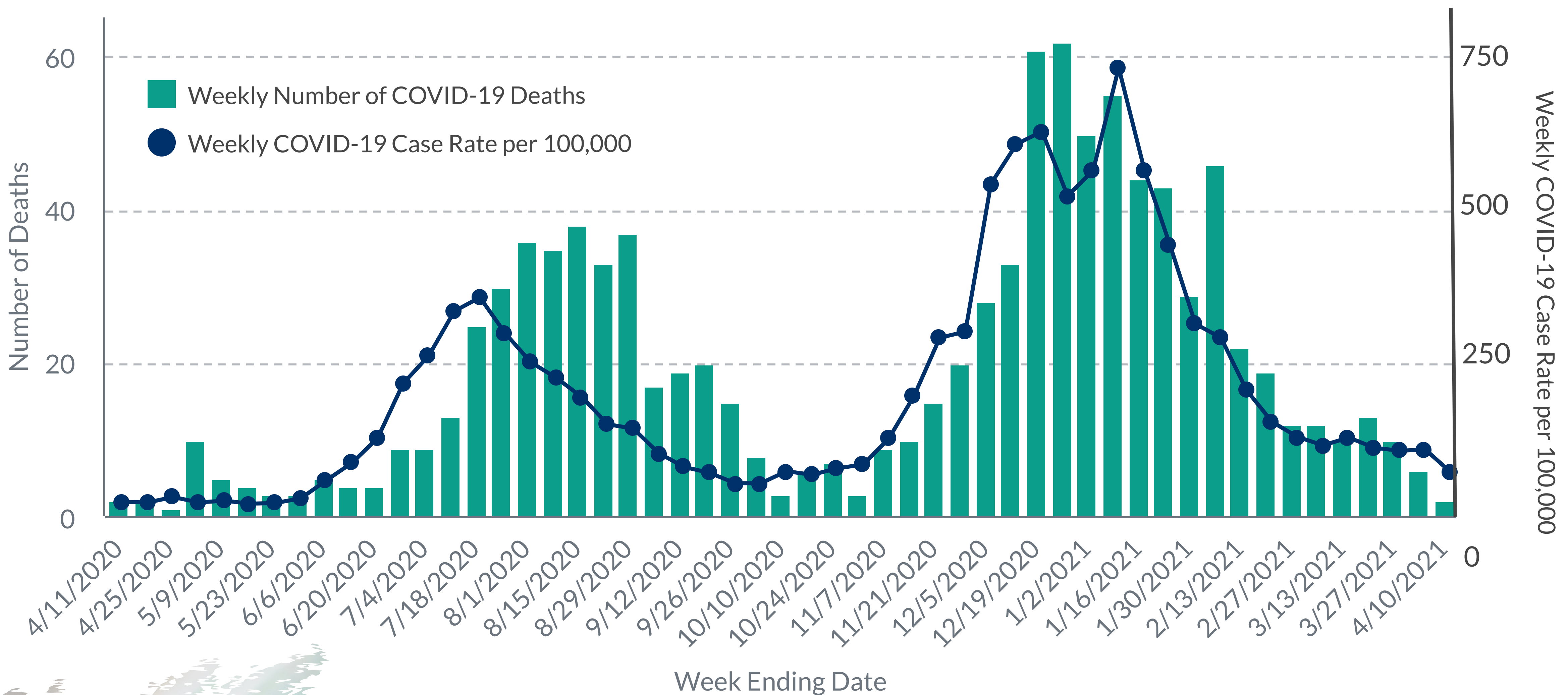



Stanislaus County COVID-19 Deaths

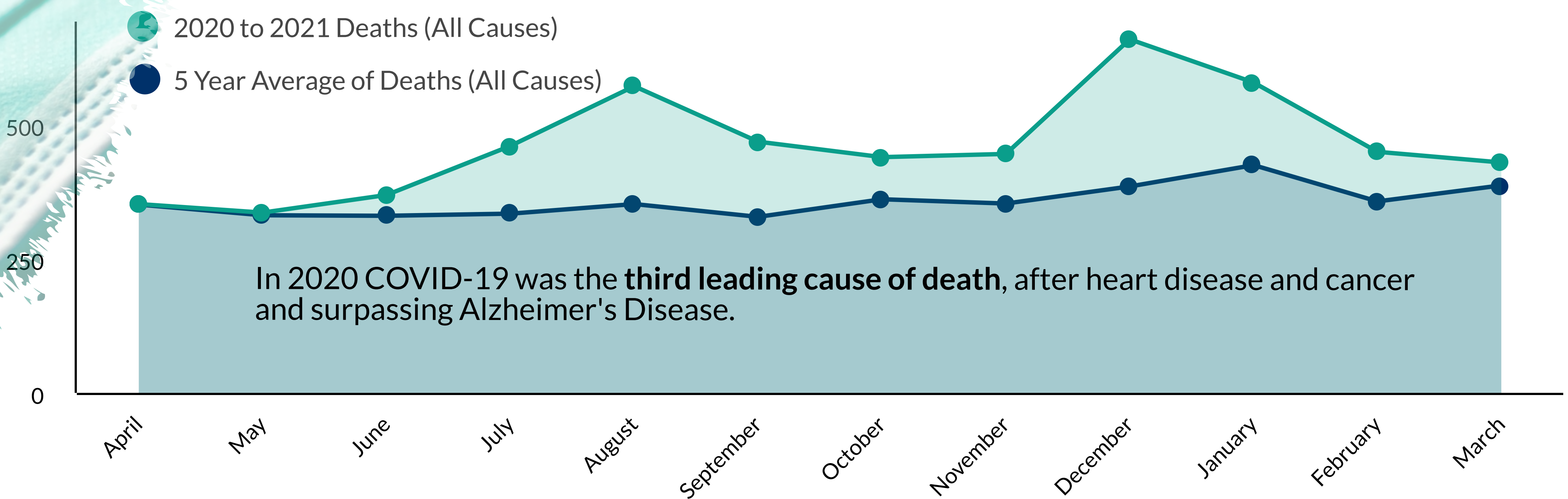
At the time of this report, 1,017 Stanislaus County residents died in the past year from COVID-19. From April 10, 2020 to April 9, 2021, **18% of all deaths** among Stanislaus County residents were **COVID-19 related**. Additionally, in 2020 there was a **22% increase** in the **total number of deaths** among Stanislaus County residents compared to the previous 5-year average. This tragic loss of life has impacted all ages, races, ethnicities, and regions within Stanislaus County. The following snapshot will overview COVID-19 mortality trends observed in the past year as well as identify the communities that have been most disparately impacted by COVID-19.



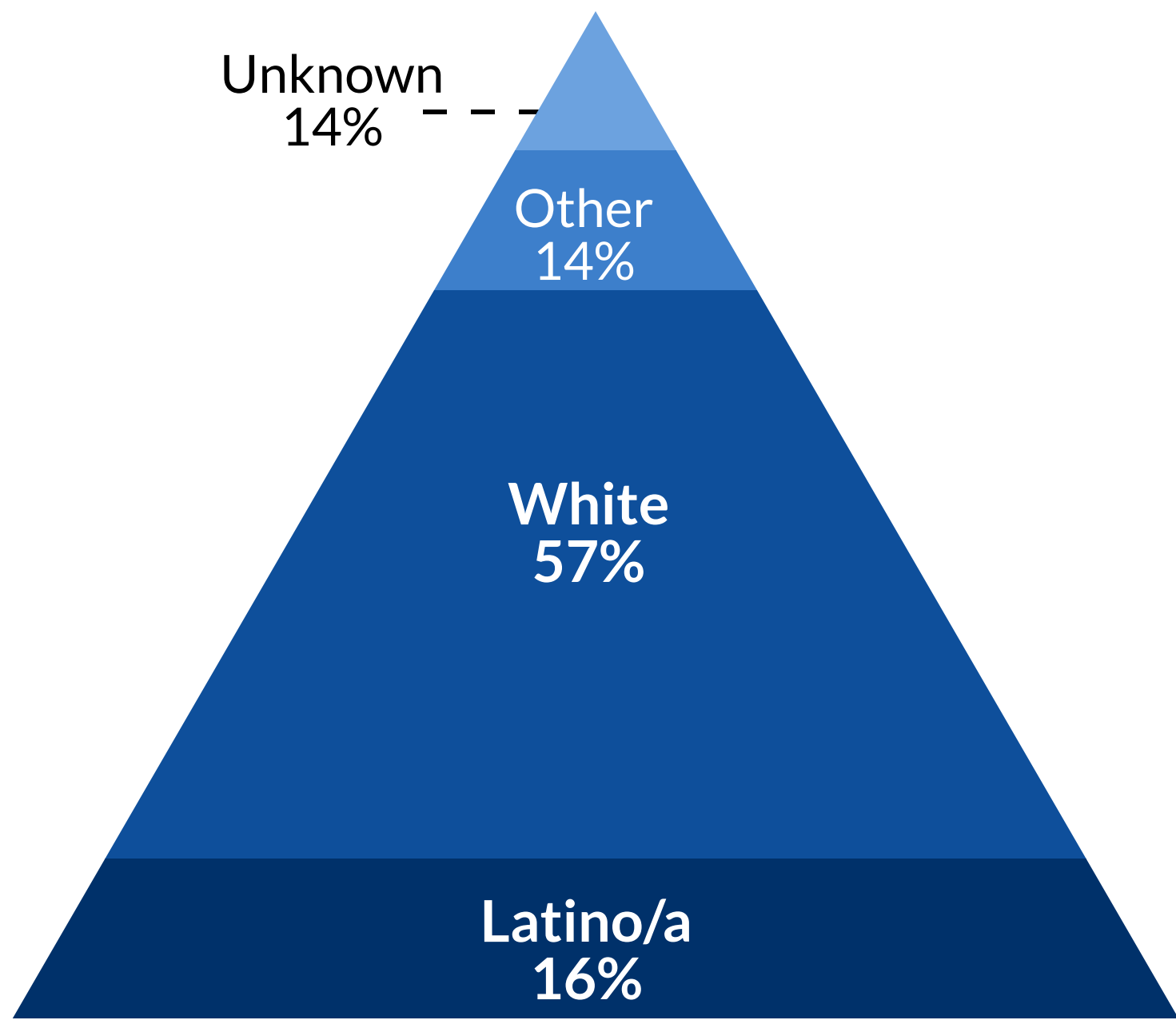
 **26%** of deaths were linked to a long-term care facility.

 **96%** were at high-risk for severe illness (Aged 65 years and older or living with an underlying health conditions).

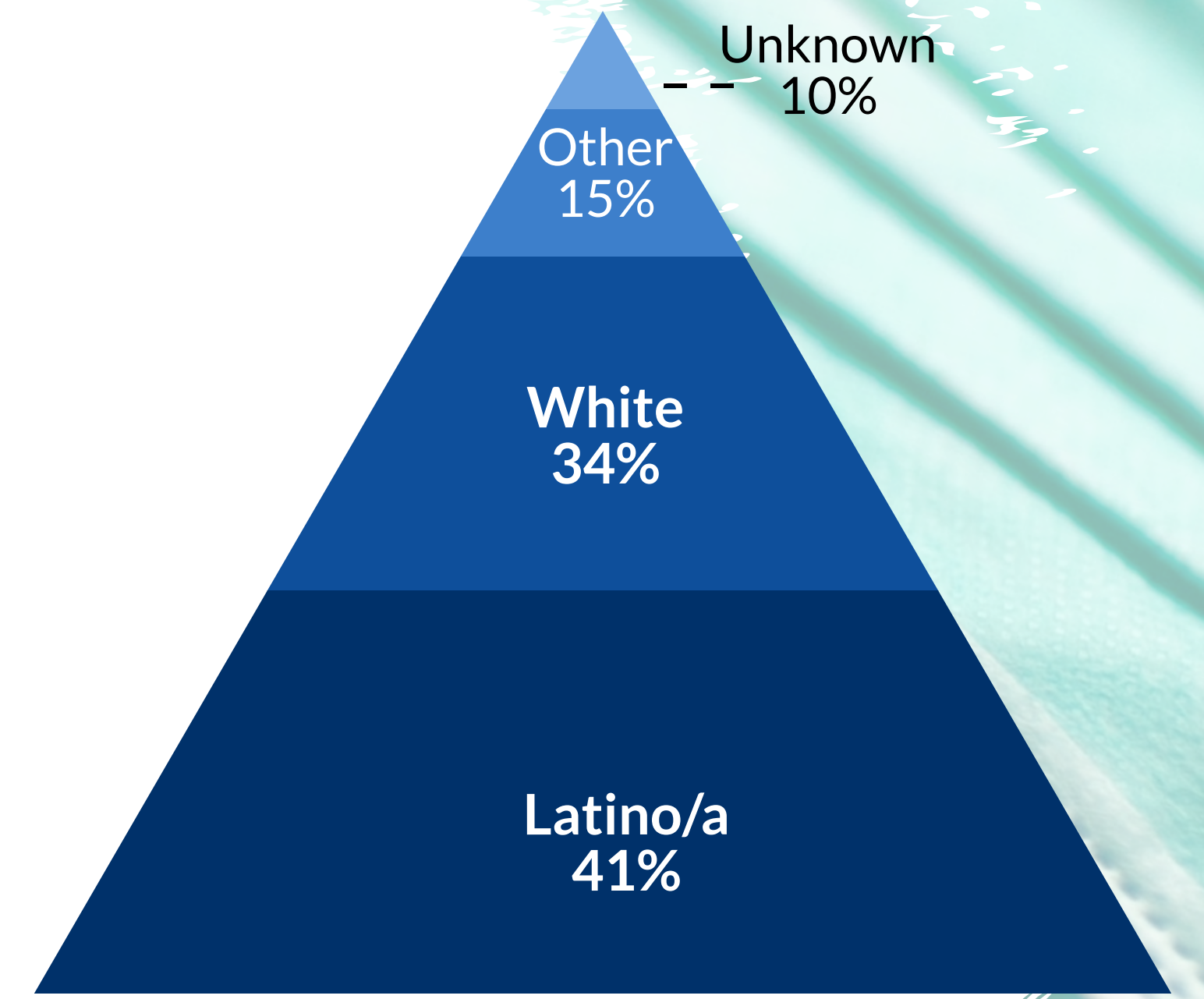

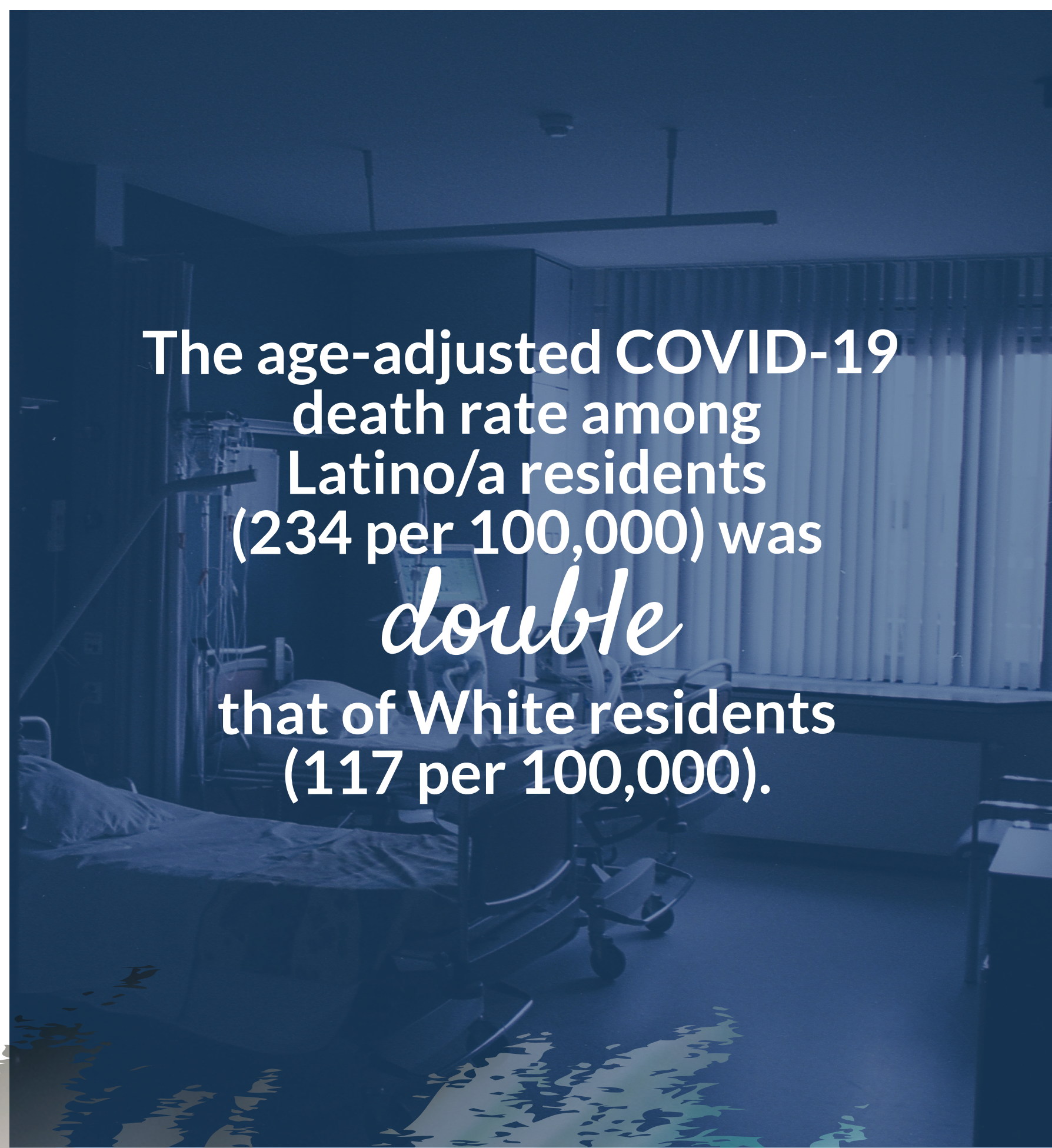

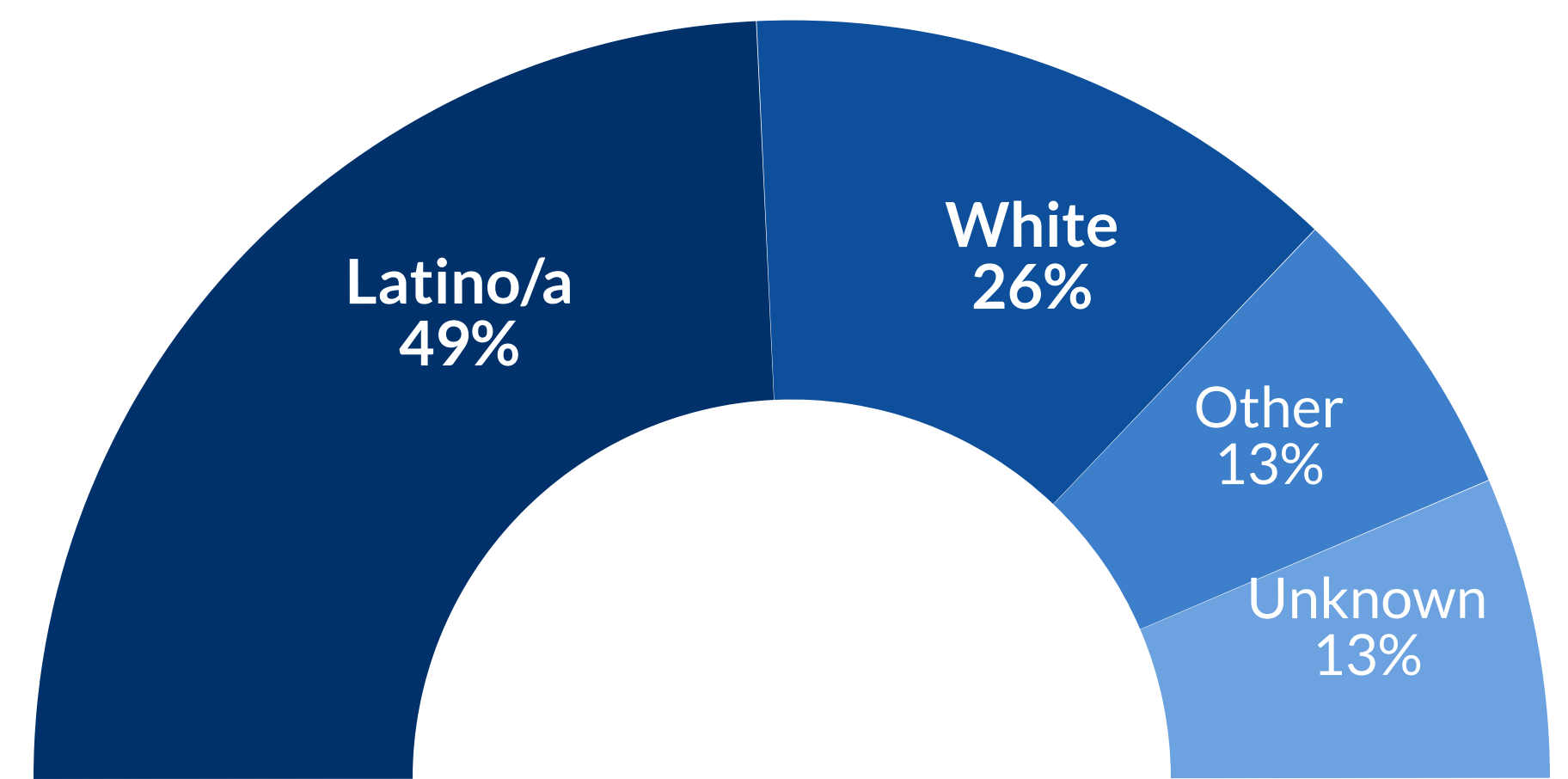

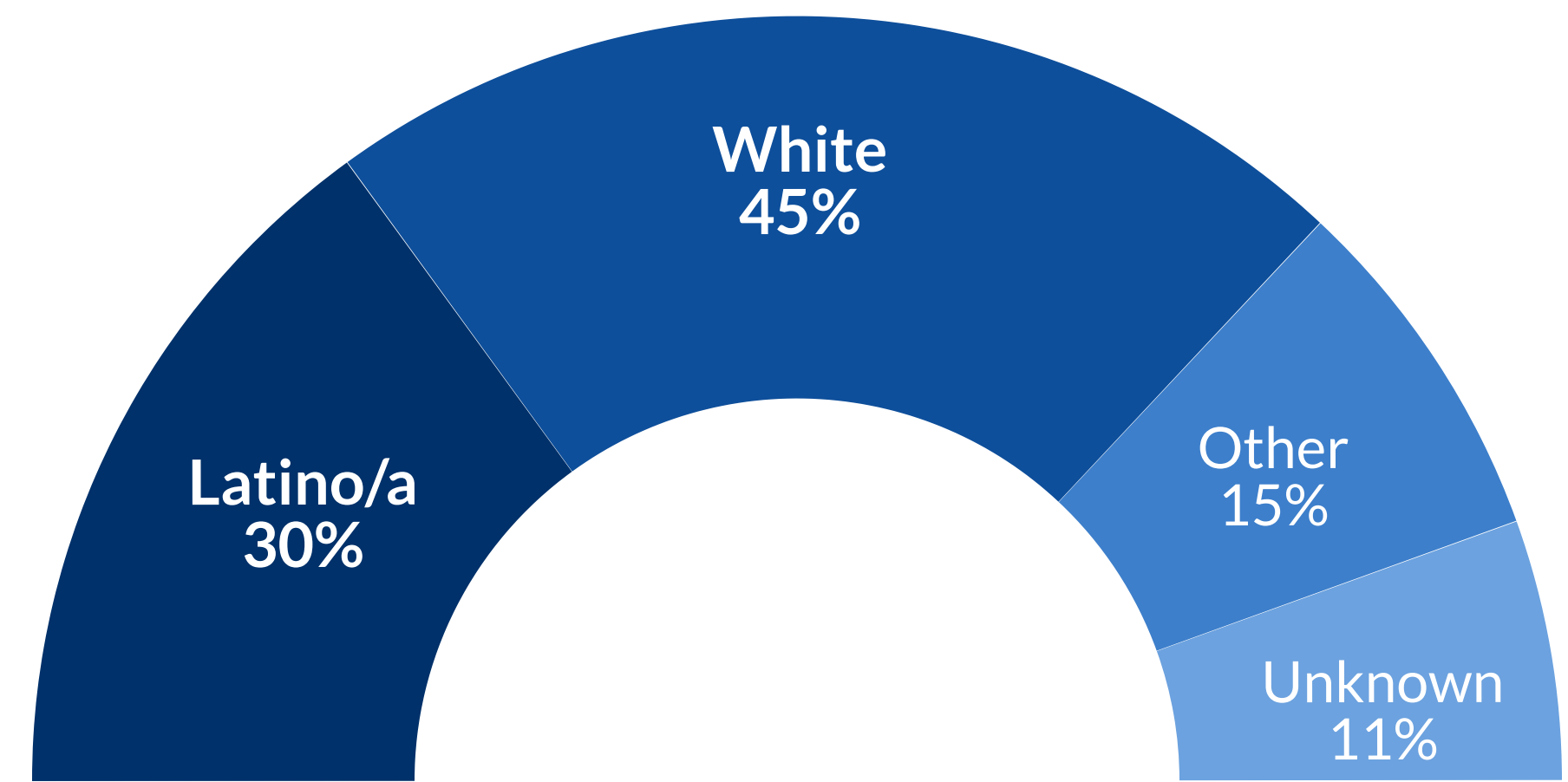
Community Deaths
